BUDGET UPDATES

- Temporary tax increase, will revisit state budget in March
- Governor's Veto's
 - 80 Million in child welfare services and federal dollars
 - Took away child care for low income families that were on assistance
 - Chapter 26.5—biggest hit to the Counties
 - Removed \$133 million for reimbursement of services for Fiscal Years 04/05 through 08/09. Suspended the mandate and SGF allocation for the current year.
 - ADMH has been meeting with Office of Education. Next meeting is 10/29/10.
 - Questions yet to be answered:
 - Will ADMH be reimbursed for services already rendered?
 - Average cost 1.5 million a year. Bulk of referrals come beginning and end of year
 - Special Ed Directors are meeting to discuss next steps
 - Medi-Cal can still be billed for applicable services

 - Agreed—Next MHSA stakeholder meeting will be in conjunction with this meeting on 11/22/10
 - Innovation Brainstorming—\$385K/year available—Fund one program and do it well
 - Integration of physical health, MH and AOD
 - Service teams
 - Consumers and Families with crisis, housing and help access benefits
 - CBT Evidence Based Practices
 - Use of Art with recovery
 - Work/employment with recovery
 - Pharmaceutical linkage
 - Day to day planning
 - Alternative targeted planning programs
 - Children's
 - Adults
 - Veterans
 - Utilize collaboration to stretch the dollars and plan

 - Accessibility
 - Discharge planning
 - Support group
